THE FOOD CORPORATION OF INDIA

New Delhi, the 5th March 1976

No. 1-5/73-EP-Vol.1.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 45 of the Food Corporations Act, 1964 (37 of 1964) and with the previous sanction of the Central Government, the Food Corporation of India hereby makes the following regulations further to amend the Food Corporation of India (Staff) Regulations, 1971, namely:—

1. (1) These Regulations may be called the Food Corporation of India (Staff) (29th amendment) Regulations, 1976.
2. (2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 9th October, 1975.

2. The following amendment should be made to the Food Corporation of India (Staff) Regulations, 1971:—

Regulation No. and Amendment

22(1)—Substitute the existing provision with the following:—

"Every employee appointed to the service of the Corporation shall retire on the last date of the month in which he attains the age of 58 years".

RESOLUTION NO. 39/176
RESOLVED that the Rules of the Council in Part VII, Chapter I be amended as follows:—

In lieu of Rule 17(2) substitute the following:—
"The date of receipt of the complaint or the date of the initiation of the proceedings at the instance of the State Bar Council shall be the date on which the State Bar Council refers the case for disposal to its Disciplinary Committee under Section 35(1)."

RESOLUTION NO. 42/1976
RESOLVED that Rule 7 in Chapter III, Part VI, be and is hereby amended as follows:—
Add the following proviso at the end of Rule 7 and its proviso:—
"Provided further that nothing in this rule shall apply to any Judge of a High Court who is not a permanent Judge thereof."

In the Employees' State Insurance Corporation (Regulations) Regulations, 1965:—
